

Secondary Education - Assistant Professor History/Social Science or Science (any discipline)

CI is accepting applications for a tenure track faculty position as a secondary-level teacher educator with specialization in one of the following areas: history/social science, **or** science (any discipline). The successful candidate will be responsible for teaching middle school and high school methods in the content area, teaching courses in the pre-requisite program, teaching courses in the MA in Education Curriculum & Instruction specialization, and supervising students in field placements and student teaching. Position may include the teaching of courses in subject matter preparation at the undergraduate level. Additional responsibilities include developing, maintaining or expanding a scholarly research agenda and assisting in maintaining programs at the post baccalaureate and Master's level, and service to the program, community, and university.

Required Qualifications:

- A Doctoral degree in Education or a related field is required.
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching secondary methods and student teaching supervision at the university level
- Demonstrated excellence in teaching multi-ethnic, multilingual and/or multicultural students in middle and high schools (minimum of three years teaching)
- Demonstrated positive relationships with school district personnel, students and their families
- A record of effective teaching using a variety of methods and technology
- Commitment to student success
- An emerging or demonstrated record of scholarship in one or more areas of emphasis in secondary education
- Evidence of commitment and ability to work in teams
- Evidence of commitment not only to one's discipline but also to one's institution
- As a condition of employment, this position will require a background check. The person holding this position is considered a 'mandated reporter' under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

- Experience in regional and national accreditation processes
- Experience in and commitment to on-going, outcomes-based, program assessment of teaching and learning
- Experience in curriculum planning, development, and implementation
- Involvement in lifelong learning and extended education programs
- Record of grant and contract acquisition
