Application Deadline Date: Review of applications will begin on October 26, 2015 and continue until the position is filled.

The candidate must be able to teach content area methods courses (i.e. Characteristics and Curricular Adaptations, Consultation and Collaboration, Assessment, Instructional Strategies, etc.) and field experience supervision in the area of mild/moderate and/or moderate/severe disabilities. The candidate will teach at the Bakersfield campus.

Required Qualifications: Earned a Clear Education Specialist Credential in the area of mild/moderate and/or moderate/severe disabilities. (1) Minimum of 3 years of K-12 public school teaching and/or clinical experience serving students with disabilities in cross-cultural settings. (2) Experience of teaching in the area of CSUB (Bakersfield) serving area.

Preferred Qualifications: Successful university level teaching and supervision experiences; Demonstration of collegial teamwork; Experience with alternative special education delivery systems that integrate special and general education services; Experience with instructional technology; Experience of working with young children with disabilities; Experience of online teaching; Holds a CSUB online teaching certification.

Background Check: A background check (including a criminal records check) must be completed satisfactorily before any candidate can be offered a position with the CSU. Failure to satisfactorily complete the background check may affect the application status of applicants or continued employment of current CSU employees who apply for the position.

Mandated Reporter: The person holding this position is considered a "mandated reporter" under the California Child Abuse and Neglect Reporting Act and is required to comply with the requirements set forth in CSU Executive Order 1083 as a condition of employment.

Compensation: Competitive, dependent upon qualifications and professional experience. The CSU offers excellent health, dental, vision, and retirement benefits.

Applications: Nominations are welcomed and encouraged. Complete applications require the following four (4) items: (1) original and personalized letter of application addressing the above requirements and qualifications; (2) current vitae; (3) copy of university transcripts verifying academic record and award of highest degree; and (4) Three professional references.
