Position: Assistant Professor, K-12 Mathematics Education or Science Education

Starting Date: Fall, 2016

Minimum Qualifications: An appropriate terminal degree (Ed.D. or Ph.D.) from an accredited university in mathematics education or science education, or a related field in education and strong background in mathematics or the physical or life sciences. Experience in K-12 classroom teaching and extensive knowledge and familiarity with CCSS Mathematics and NGSS. An active and on-going record of scholarship in mathematics education or science education in K-12 urban environments. Post-secondary classroom teaching experience in mathematics education or science education courses using hybrid, face to face and online modalities. Record of, or potential for scholarly activity involving students whenever possible, as well as the demonstrated potential for effective teaching of mathematics or science courses using a variety of pedagogical strategies. Demonstrated ability and/or interest in working in a multiethnic, multicultural environment.

As a University dedicated to engagement, service and the public good, the successful candidate will be expected to join faculty, staff, students and administrators in a commitment to these purposes.

Preferred Qualifications: Specialized knowledge in the area of mathematics education or science education, including curriculum standards, assessment, instructional methods, curriculum adaptations, collaboration with special education, or other areas of expertise. Experience with professional development, university teaching, and/or field supervision. Knowledge of 21st century teaching and learning and a developed understanding of technology, online learning, and education. Familiarity with the CalState Teach program and use of technology as a mobile learning tool.

Duties: Principal duties include teaching online and face to face in the credential and master's degree programs within Charter College of Education and CalState TEACH, as well as supervising student teaching using various tools and in person, student advisement and mentoring, and committee within Charter College of Education and CalState TEACH and the University.
