Minimum Qualifications

- Earned degree in education or closely related field from an accredited institution of higher education by date of appointment with a strong background in at least one of the following: elementary STEM, science/engineering education (elementary), California history, multicultural or psychological foundations; or related areas that pertain to school climate and learning in diverse classrooms or high-needs schools.
- Three or more years of successful K-12 teaching in urban school environments with linguistically, culturally, and economically diverse students, preferably at the elementary level.
- Commitment to urban education, diversity, inclusion, and student academic and social excellence.
- Evidence of exemplary teaching in K-12 school and/or university settings.
- Demonstrated ability to use a variety of instructional methodologies.
- Willingness and ability to work collaboratively with colleagues.
