- Participating in and expanding partnerships with area schools to foster excellent field experiences and job prospects for our candidates;

- Understanding of Common Core State Standards and its integration into content areas.
- Commitment to urban education, diversity, inclusion, and student academic and social excellence.
- Evidence of exemplary teaching in K-8 school and university settings.
- Demonstrated ability to use a variety of instructional methodologies.
- Willingness and ability to work collaboratively with colleagues.
- Knowledge and successful integration of technology in planning and teaching.
- A publication agenda related to curriculum and instruction.
- Expertise in English language learning theories, practice, and pedagogy.
