The Department of Special Education, Rehabilitation and Counseling invites applications for a tenure track Assistant Professor position beginning September, 2016. The Special Education program includes the California Education Specialist teaching credentials in Early Childhood Special Education, K-12 Mild to Moderate disabilities, and K-12 Moderate to Severe disabilities accredited by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing as well as a master's degree program.

California State University, San Bernardino is a comprehensive regional university that serves approximately 18,000 students, and offers 47 undergraduate, 30 graduate and one doctoral degree program and 13 academic programs with national accreditation. CSUSB is committed to providing learning opportunities that are driven by teaching and research excellence, intellectual interaction, creativity and diversity.

TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:

The successful candidate will be required to (a) teach evening courses in face-to-face, hybrid, and/or online formats in the post-baccalaureate credential and graduate programs including strands in special education foundations, instructional practices for learners with mild/moderate disabilities, English language development, literacy (reading, writing, listening, and speaking) and literacy assessment for K-12 students with special needs; (b) supervise and evaluate fieldwork activities, (c) advise credential and graduate students; (d) participate in curriculum development and ongoing program assessment activities; and (e) participate in scholarly activity and service. Rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications and experience. The successful candidate may be required to teach courses at both the San Bernardino and Palm Desert Campuses.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Qualifications for this position include: (1) earned doctorate in special education or closely related field, doctoral students graduating by August 31, 2016 will be considered; (2) minimum of three (3) years of public school teaching experience with students with mild to moderate disabilities; (3) experience in higher education teaching (for an appointment to higher rank); (4) commitment to teaching, research, and service to the university, community, and to the profession; (5) a strong potential for or record of research and publications.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

Evidence of scholarly activity, publication, and innovation is valued. Evidence of exemplary graduate-level teaching and leadership experience at program level is preferred. Evidence of expertise in literacy learning and/or instructional practices for students who are English learners are highly desirable. Screening of applications will begin 10/30/15 and may continue until the position is filled.
