The Department of Educational Leadership and Technology is seeking applications for an enthusiastic and dynamic tenure-track, open rank professor position in Educational Administration. Requirements for the position include administration experience in a K-12 school setting. Teaching experience at the university level is preferred. Primary responsibilities include, but not limited to: teaching graduate level courses in educational leadership; have demonstrated ability to teach graduate courses on and off-campus in educational leadership in two or more of the following areas:

1) supervision; 2) educational leadership; 3) diversity; 4) school finance; and 5) school law. Work experience at the school and/or district level and possession of a Professional Administrative Services Credential (or equivalent) are preferred.

California State University, San Bernardino is a comprehensive regional university that serves approximately 18,000 students, and offers 47 undergraduate, 30 graduate and one doctoral degree program and 13 academic programs with national accreditation. CSUSB is committed to providing learning opportunities that are driven by teaching and research excellence, intellectual interaction, creativity and diversity.

### **TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:**

Candidates must have an earned doctorate in Educational Leadership or related field from an accredited institution and practical administrative experience at the K-12 building and/or district levels in educational leadership. Desirable qualifications include; a demonstrated record of research and knowledge of research methodologies, and scholarly publications; teaching experience at the higher education level; skill in online and other alternative delivery systems; ability to work collaboratively with colleagues, willingness to teach off campus, and commitment to and experience with diversity issues.

Rank and salary are commensurate with qualifications and experience. The successful candidate will be required to teach a range of courses in educational leadership for on and off campus cohorts, including both the San Bernardino and Palm Desert Campuses.

### **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

Professional qualifications include: 1) Doctorate degree in educational leadership (or related

field) with a preference given to those with a doctorate degree in Educational Leadership or related field. The doctorate is required for tenure; 2) evidence of successful teaching and a minimum of 5 years administrative experience; 3) evidence of ability to establish a program of research and scholarly activity and presentation at the state, national and international level; 4) willingness to travel within the region to advise and recruit students and teach on and off campus; 5) ability to work with state organizations in aligning course content with state mandates; 7) ability to supervise educational administration fieldwork, independent studies, and focused student research.

A background check (including a criminal records check) must be completed satisfactorily before any candidate can be offered a position with the CSU. Failure to satisfactorily complete the background check may affect application status of applicants or continued employment of current CSU employees who apply for the position.

### **SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:**

Evidence of scholarly activity, publication, and innovation is valued, as is a demonstrated commitment to diversity issues. Screening of applications will begin December 1, 2015 and may continue until the position is filled.
