Overview: The College of Education at California State University San Bernardino (CSUSB) seeks an innovative and experienced leader to chair the Department of Teacher Education and Foundations. The Department Chair will encourage and support a cross-disciplinary faculty that build on educational foundations and on the mission of CSUSB.

California State University, San Bernardino is a comprehensive regional university that serves approximately 18,000 students, and offers 47 undergraduate, 30 graduate, doctoral degree programs and 13 academic programs with national accreditation.

TYPICAL ACTIVITIES:

The Department Chair is responsible for overall leadership and administration of the department including oversight of academic programs, faculty review, course scheduling, budget, support of faculty productivity, professional development, and facilitation of innovation. This is an administrative position, with the Chair serving on the Dean's Cabinet and related college committees.

The 26 faculty and 2 administrative staff support the undergraduate: Minor programs in Education, Gender and Sexuality Studies, Education Minor, teacher candidates in elementary and secondary and M.A degrees: Curriculum and Instruction, Holistic and Integrated Studies, Mathematics and Science, Reading and TESOL. Our core strengths are our talented and successful students and alumni, our strong school district partnerships, and our commitment to substantive collaboration with our college and community partners. The Department seeks a leader who will build on these strengths and encourage new initiatives.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

1. A doctoral degree from an accredited university with a specialty in one of the teaching areas represented within the department.
2. A distinguished record of scholarship and teaching that merits appointment as a tenured full professor in an area represented within the department.
3. Administrative experience in an academic unit.
4. Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
5. Demonstrated commitment to educational and cultural needs of diverse populations.
6. Experience with externally-funded projects.

SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION:

New faculty members are encouraged to develop and participate in activities that support the University's strategic plan. This plan emphasizes: a) teaching and learning excellence; b) student access, retention, and success; c) faculty and student engagement in research and scholarship; d) provision of a safe, accessible, and diverse intellectual, social, and cultural campus environment; and e) meaningful partnerships with the communities that the university serves.

Upon submission of application, include vita, copy of your most recent transcripts, and letter of application that includes statement on teaching philosophy and strategies, research/professional accomplishments and goals, as well as a description of any interest or experience in one or more of the university's strategic plan areas.
